Motor Fuel Tax Refund Claims

Statewide fuel contracts may require customers (state agencies, local jurisdictions, and non-profits) to pay Maryland Motor Fuel Taxes on Gasoline, E-85, ULS Diesel, and B-5 Diesel. Statewide fuel customers may seek refunds for eligible tax paid on fuel purchased from a vendor under contract with the Department of General Services and used in the operation of state vehicles. The fuel must be used only by the state agency.

The Comptroller of Maryland allows claims for refunds of eligible motor fuel taxes. The following links provide more information on the types of refunds, eligibility, procedures for claims, invoice requirements, and the appropriate forms and instructions.
