The fee for each project awarded under the proposed agreement shall be negotiated and the contract will be approved and executed by the State individually. Projects will normally be awarded on a rotating basis beginning with the number one ranked firm. Once the project award process has been initiated with a firm in the normal rotation, the next opportunity for project award will go to the next firm in the rotation.
